Teeba is one of the largest producers of dairy products in Jordan, and a subsidiary of Almarai Company, under the joint venture IDJ.

As a leader in the Jordanian market, Teeba is working to embed sustainability within its operations. The sustainability management is currently decentralized but coordinated by Teeba's Quality and regulatory Department.

This section of the report outlines Teeba's approach to managing sustainability and highlights the achievements it has made in 2019 and its plans for the year ahead.

Over the past year, Teeba has implemented several initiatives to optimize energy and water consumption from process and equipment modifications. In 2019, Teeba converted its boilers to heavy fuel oil from diesel. This modification will contribute to reducing the carbon intensity of Teeba's manufacturing facilities. Teeba is also in the process of switching to LED lighting. In total, lighting loads will be reduced by up to an estimated 15%. Following the review of cleaning processes, the modifications Teeba has made have further supported reducing overall water and energy use requirement.

In 2019, Teeba commissioned a 0.35 MWp solar array at its head offices, contributing 50% of the site's total energy consumption in 2019 alone. In 2020, further planning for a 0.5 MWp solar array at Teeba's manufacturing plant is scheduled pending approval from the Jordanian Electric Power Company.
